Statement	<p>The transportation system is continually reviewed to ensure that the appropriate number of school buses and capacity meets the needs of eligible students. The system is designed with the intent that those registered are riding regularly and it is the primary transportation for the student(s). Students are not permitted to use school bus transportation on an as needed basis.</p>
Eligibility	<p>In order to maintain a seat on the school bus, students must use the service as their primary mode of transportation.</p> <p>Regular usage is defined as using the service at least two days (2) out of a possible five (5) days in a regular school week. The same applies even if a student is assigned to the AM or PM only.</p> <p>If service involves a route extension, deviation from the route or the bus is only providing service for one student, the frequency of required usage increases to four (4) out of a possible five (5) days. The same applies to those requesting AM or PM only.</p> <p>This is due to the disruption to route timing which impacts other families as well as in the interest of fiscal responsibility.</p> <p>Exceptions will be made in shared family situations.</p> <p>Frequency will be monitored via regular communication with the bus operators as well as through route audits.</p> <p>If students are identified as not using the service on a regular basis, students will be removed from the passenger list. Parents/guardians will be notified via the school.</p> <p>At any time, service may be re-instated should regular service be required.</p>
