Allergies & Food Restrictions

Minimizing Health Risks for Students with Life Threatening Food Allergies

Food allergies can be life threatening. The risk of accidental exposure to foods can be reduced if we all work together to minimize risk and take measures to provide a safe environment for food-allergic students.

Buses are a "NO FOOD ZONE". The buses transport students with food allergy restrictions and it is critical that we have everyone's compliance to make sure the buses are kept clean & food free to minimize everyone's risk.

Please ensure students are ready several minutes ahead of the bus schedule. As safety is paramount when students are concerned School Bus Drivers are instructed that students are to be picked up and delivered to their designated pick up/drop off points only.

Please note that should a student miss the bus, the parents/guardians are responsible to drive the student to school and not to the next bus stop.

IMPORTANT:

Parents/guardians must go to the bus stop to meet their child enrolled in junior kindergarten, senior kindergarten. They may also entrust a responsible person with this task. A sibling may act in this regard but must be at least 11 years of age and must have parental permission via a letter to the RRDTS.

If a driver encounters a situation where no one is visible, the child will be kept on the bus and delivered back to the school.

When a child has been returned to the school, it will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian to provide transportation home.
