Statement	<p>Only those students residing in the school's attendance zone and meeting the walking distance requirements stipulated in the walking distance policy, may use school transportation services.</p> <p>No student residing outside of the school's attendance zone will be picked up or dropped off at an address outside the school catchment area.</p>
Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. When a student's primary address is located outside the school's attendance zone, the parent/guardian may ask RRDTS to grant a courtesy seat for this student, in accordance with Procedure 207 Courtesy Transportation if the student goes into school zone for pick-up/drop-off.2. When the address of a student's caregiver is located outside the school's attendance zone, the parent/guardian may <u>NOT</u> ask RRDTS to grant a courtesy seat for this student, in accordance with Procedure 207 Courtesy Transportation.3. When an elementary student's primary address is located outside the school's attendance zone, but the address of the student's caregiver falls within the school's attendance zone, the parent/guardian may ask RRDTS to grant a courtesy seat for this student to travel between the school and the caregiver, in accordance with Procedure 207 Courtesy Transportation.4. When an elementary student's primary address is located outside the school's attendance zone, but the parent/guardian accepts a group stop location within zone, the parent/guardian may ask RRDTS to grant a courtesy seat for this student to travel between the school and the bus stop within zone in accordance with Procedure 207 Courtesy Transportation.5. Use a Student Transportation Information Form F11 to apply.
