<b>Statement</b>	RRDTS recognizes that parents and guardians may require childcare for their children. Transportation to/from a caregiver may be provided by applying the criteria herewithin.
<b>Procedures</b>	<p>The provision of transportation to and from a caregiver is dependent upon the following criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The parent/guardian submits a written request to the principal on an annual basis using a Student Transportation Information Form F11.</li> <li>2. The student is eligible for transportation under 200 Transportation Eligibility.</li> <li>3. The addition of the student to the alternate bus does not cause that student load to exceed the rated capacity of the vehicle.</li> <li>4. The transportation follows a regular and manageable weekly schedule for the school year. Requests for changes under one week (1 to 4 days) do not constitute a regular and fixed patten and therefore will not be considered.</li> <li>5. Only existing stops approved by RRDTS are used.</li> <li>6. The student normally rides on the same bus in both directions.</li> <li>7. The alternate transportation does not require transferring from one bus to another.</li> <li>8. The caregiver's address is within the attendance zone of the student's home school in accordance with 203 Out-of-Boundary Students.</li> <li>9. Parents/guardians understand that this accommodation is subject to the conditions listed in this policy detail and may be withdrawn immediately upon notice that:             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Student behaviour is unacceptable;</li> <li>b) Changes in the population of the area result in transportation needs which exceed the maximum allowable number of students on a bus.</li> </ol> </li> </ol>
