What is the Transportation Consortium?

In April 2012, the Rainy River District School Board and the Northwest Catholic District School Board signed a membership agreement to provide transportation services to students in a coordinated way. A Joint Transportation Policy was created and approved by both boards in June 2012. The Joint Transportation Policy and many new procedures are now in effect.

What is the role of the Consortium?

The Rainy River District Transportation Services:

- **Plans transportation routes for schools**
- **Checks all stops for safety and feasibility**
- **Works with bus operators and school boards to communicate cancellations and delays**
- **Processes all transportation requests for new students and changes to transportation. All requests are generated directly through schools to the consortium**

Creating Efficiencies

By working together, both boards are able to share routes and other transportation services. This collaborative approach results in better service for students and greater efficiencies for both boards.
