Need to change your student(s) transportation?

In order to make a change to your child(ren) transportation you must fill out an *F11- Student Transportation Information* form at their respective school. We do NOT accept changes via phone or e-mail. Please be aware that the first few weeks of school startup are extremely busy and the form states we have 3 business days upon receiving the form to complete the request. The F11 form can be found on our website under the 'forms' section.

Know your Route ID's, AM & PM

A student(s) bus route ID may be different in the PM from the AM Route. Please ensure that you know the Route ID for both AM & PM as this is very important during bus delays & cancellations.

Buses are a 100% "NO FOOD ZONE"

Buses transport students with food allergy restrictions and it is critical that everyone is compliant to make sure that buses are kept clean & food free to minimize anyone at risk.

Food allergies can be life threatening. The risk of accidental exposure to foods can be reduced if we all work together to minimize risk and take measures to provide a safe environment for food-allergic students.
