## Need to change your student(s) transportation?

Please be aware that the first few weeks of school startup are extremely busy and the form states we have 3 business days upon receiving the form to complete the request. All changes must be in writing and forms filled out at your student(s) school they are registered at.

### Buses are a 100% "NO FOOD ZONE"

Buses transport students with food allergy restrictions and it is critical that everyone is compliant to make sure that buses are kept clean & food free to minimize anyone at risk.

**Food allergies can be life threatening.** The risk of accidental exposure to foods can be reduced if we all work together to minimize risk and take measures to provide a safe environment for food-allergic students.

## Walking?
