Student Transportation Changes

All changes to a student's address (primary & alternative) must be completed on a Student Transportation Information Form– F11 @ their respective school. The form must be completed in its entirety by the parent/legal guardian before the RRDTSC can proceed with the request. Once approved the updated transportation information will be sent back to the school within 3 business days.

PLEASE NOTE: Parents must provide up-to-date information to the schools regarding custody arrangements.
