# STOP-SCHOOL BUS!

Thinking about passing a stopped school bus? DON'T!

Passing a school bus with its upper red lights flashing is not only against the law but dangerous.

First Offence:

- ◆ \$400 to \$2,000 plus six demerit points



Each subsequent offence:

- ◆ \$1,000 to \$4,000, six demerit points and possible jail time up to six months.

Drivers and vehicle owners will be charged if their vehicle illegally passes a stopped school bus.

- ◆ As a motorist you must stop when approaching a stopped school bus with its upper red lights flashing
- ◆ Do not move until the red lights have stopped flashing or the bus begins to move
- ◆ When travelling on a roadway or coming from the opposite direction (4-lane highway) you are required to stop
