Statement	Where late runs are established as a Courtesy Route for transportation for students to participate in extra-curricular activities, the responsibility is solely that of the student to meet all timetables. If a bus is missed, it is the parent's or student's responsibility to find appropriate transportation to her/her home.
Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In general, late bus runs shall only service main roads. 2. A list of students using late bus runs shall be kept in the principal's office. 3. The Late Bus may run if there is a minimum of 10 students signed up in the school office by Friday of the week for service the following week. If there is not the minimum number of students signed up to ride, there will be no courtesy Late Bus. 4. The Late Bus is considered a courtesy route, and if the route is not operated on a particular day, then it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to arrange alternative transportation. 5. The Late Bus shall service, but not be limited to, the secondary schools within the Fort Frances, Rainy River, and Atikokan areas.
